## **REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

Sealed proposals are being sought from pre-qualified vendors until 2:00 pm on **January 27<sup>th</sup>, January 31**, 2012 by the Dorchester County Health Department's School Wellness Center Program for a stand-alone School Wellness Center Facility at North Dorchester High School as described in these documents. The procurement, construction and placement of this work will be managed by the Facilities Staff of DCPS in cooperation with DCHD Wellness Center administration. The award and payment of this work will be made by the DCHD.

Proposers must:

- Be licensed by the State of Maryland and provide proof of same.
- Have a minimum of 5 years experience in business
- Be able to provide at least 5 references for similar, successful institutional projects in the State of Maryland.

A pre-proposal meeting will be held on January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2012 at 10:00 am at North Dorchester High School, 5875 Cloverdale Road, Hurlock, MD, 21643. All submitters are encouraged to attend. Attendance is not mandatory but will be a component of the evaluation process.
